# **Broad edged nibs**

You don't need all of them . You can choose between A, B or C (I mainly use Tape or Brause).

A: Speedball: C2, C3 e C5

**B:** Tape: Tape 3, Tape 2 e Tape 1

**C:** Brause Bandzug: 3mm, 2mm, and Tape 1 or Speedball C<sub>5</sub> (for smaller size, I prefer more flexible nibs)

**D:** 2 pen holders

## **PAPER**

**E:** A3 paper 90 grams paper, good quality non-bleeding paper, with some texture: Blocks like Canson Croquis or Fabriano Skizzi, Daler-Rowney Arteco Sketching Esquisse, or similar (the paper needs to be light enough to show the guidelines)

### INK

**F:** Higgins Eternal, Pelikan 4001, or walnut ink.

#### **OTHER**

**G:** 1 brush (cheap) for fill your pen **H:** 2 clips

Pencil, tape, paper for hand-guard, eraser, and straight edge/T- square.

### **OPTIONAL**

good quality gouache, Chinese Stick Ink & Ink Stone (quality), some sheets of good paper
