Each piece must be labeled, framed, and wired for hanging. A work's inclusion for exhibition will be at the sole discretion of the SoS Exhibition Committee.

Work should be delivered the morning of the installation on Sunday, February 25, between 9:30 am and 12:30 pm, to the Trask Gallery in the National Arts Club, 15 Gramercy Park South, New York City (20th Street between Park Avenue and Irving Place).
